	Suggesting	We could go to the cinema
	Ability in the past	I could climb mountains when I was young
May	Future possibility (more probable)	He may come to the party
Might	Future possibility (less probable)	He might come to the party
Must	Obligation	You must wear a crash helmet when cycling
	Prohibition	You mustn't park here
Shall	Offers	Shall I close the window?
	Suggesting	Shall we go to the cinema?
Should	Advice	You should study a lot for your exams
Will	Previsions	It will rain tomorrow
	Immediate decisions	I will go to the cinema alone
	Promises	I promise I will be good
Would	Offers	Would you like some sweets?
	Expressing preferences	I'd like to go to the pub tonight
